Learning this week

In English we have continued to explore our book Kensuke's Kingdom. Children have been developing their inference and prediction skills when responding to a text, and using evidence to support their answers.



In maths children have been

revisiting fractions. This has involved simplifying fractions, comparing and ordering fractions with the same denominators and the same numerators. We will then begin to look at adding and subtracting fractions.

The children have really got stuck into our Japanese topic. We have learnt about how earthquakes occur and the impact they have on a location, and how people adapt to survive. They then explored and identified the physical geography of Japan. We discussed four islands of Japan and their physical geography. Children then compared the physical features to the UK.
